Last payments due

Trophy and dress rehearsals

Trophy week will be the week before recital. Wear your costume to class! One parent allowed! This will be held at Studio G

Rehearsals

Rehearsals will be held at the Slidell Auditorium. Be sure to check what time your child's class rehearses. It may be different than their normal class time!

Trophy Week/Dress Rehearsals

We will be holding our annual trophy/dress rehearsal week at the Studio, the week before recital, May 10th- 13th, 2021. Only one parent per child is allowed to come. Although the city has been moved to a modified “phase three,” We are still basically in “phase two” according to the open safely rules that we as a business have to follow. This means we are not able to operate at full capacity yet. All parents must wear a mask in order to enter the studio. One parent per family will be allowed to sit in class and watch their child receive their trophy. We suggest that the parent who will be helping dress the dancer for the day of the recital be the one present as we will be reviewing the costumes to make sure everyone is dressed correctly!

Attention all Monday classical ballet classes with Mrs. Carmen and Mrs. Lynsey: We ask that everyone come for dress rehearsal/trophy week Monday, May 10th at **6:00pm**! All three classes will be dancing in the same dance, and we would like time to review the dance together as one dance! This will be especially helpful for our 5:00 and 6:00 classes.

Attention All Monday tap classes with Mrs. Loren: We will be rehearsing all tap dances Monday, May 10th,2021 at **7:00pm** after the ballet rehearsal!

Rehearsal Rules

The children have worked very hard and are eager to perform for you! This is their special time, so we are doing everything we can to put on a great show everyone can enjoy while ensuring the safety and well-being of all parties involved. Throughout the multiple years of recital experience, we have found the key to putting on a successful recital depends upon addressing and adhering to several important rules. This year, due to Covid- 19, we will have to follow a few new rules set forth by the Auditorium. Please read the rules below. Please make sure you let all of your guest know the rules. Thank you, in advance, for helping us make this a recital to remember.

Please arrive 10 minutes early at the **Slidell Auditorium** for your scheduled rehearsal time. Your child will need to warm up and stretch on their own. Please keep in mind that we are on a strict schedule and cannot wait for your child if you are late. Rehearsals are VERY important. This will be the time your child learns their spot on stage, how to get to and from the stage, where backstage is etc. This will be also the last time you can get any questions answered. Teachers will not be able to help you the day of the recital.

Due to Covid-19, we must follow a few rules set forth by the Auditorium.

1. All parents and guardians will be required to wear a mask to rehearsal. You will be asked to leave immediately if you do not comply. Dancers will not have to wear a mask while they dance. All dancers 6 and up will be required to wear a mask when waiting for their turn to dance.
2. All dancers will be required to sanitize their hands before entering the stage. Studio G will have hand sanitizer for the dancers.
3. Do not congregated anywhere inside the Auditorium after your child’s rehearsal. You will not be allowed to sit and watch other rehearsals.
4. If you or your dancer are sick, or have come in contact with someone who is sick, we ask that you NOT come to the rehearsal.

Recital Rules 2021

1. Every guest **MUST** wear a mask. You will not be allowed into the auditorium without one. Studio G and the Auditorium will **NOT** provide a mask for you or your guests. Dancers and young children 5 and under will not have to wear a mask. Anyone that causes problems about wearing a mask will be escorted out of the facility.
2. No more than 30 people are allowed to be in the dressing room at one time. Please dress your child and then come back to the audience. You will not be allowed to congregate in the dressing rooms.
3. Children are not allowed to roam the facility unattended.
4. Do not touch what is not yours. If it breaks you will be responsible to cover the cost of replacing the item NOT Studio G or its staff. This includes anything your child breaks. (Refer to rule three.)
5. No outside food or drinks will be allowed during the rehearsals OR recitals. You will be asked to leave the premises if outside food or drinks are found.
6. Clean up after yourself and your children.
7. Doors Open 30 minutes prior to the start of each show. Only one parent of dancers in our opening number will be allowed in the building prior to doors opening. All other family members will be asked to wait for the doors to open.
8. Dancers and one parent per family will receive wrist bands. These wrist bands must be worn in order to get into the facility without a ticket. If you lose your band you will need to purchase a ticket.
9. DO NOT lose your tickets. The people collecting tickets do not work at Studio G and will not know if your child is a dancer or not. They have been hired to collect tickets, not to figure out what to do if you lost yours! It is **YOUR** responsibility to keep track of your tickets.
10. Do not lose your program cards and/or flower bouquet cards. You will need to turn them in on the day of the recital to receive your order. (You will receive these during trophy week)
11. Do not sit in the reserved seating even if it is empty. Anyone sitting in the reserved seating will be asked to leave the premises.
12. No saving seats allowed. Seating is on first come first serve basis. Anyone seen reserving seats will be asked to leave the premises. On the same note, do not steal seats. Parents will be moving throughout show while helping their children change. If we see people arguing over seats, both parties will be asked to leave immediately. Please remember this event is for the children. Let's keep it a happy event.
13. Anyone with a parent wristband will be allowed to sit on the first row to watch their child perform for their child's numbers **ONLY!** Please try to sit spaced apart from the other parents if possible, during your child's dance. These people will be the only ones allowed sit in the media section. Anyone without a parent wristband caught sitting in the front row will be escorted off the premises immediately.

14. You or your guest may NOT set up video cameras! Please keep in mind that you will be receiving an edited, professional video of the recital. We ask that you be mindful of blocking people if you choose to video your child.
15. Performers must come dressed and ready to perform for their first number. All performers must wear a cover up in the audience. If they have not performed their dance yet.
16. NO Tap shoes allowed in the audience.
17. Do not tape, nail, tack or otherwise fasten anything to the auditorium walls and/ or ceilings. You will be billed for all repairs.
18. NO helium balloons allowed in the facility. You will be billed \$100 per balloon
19. NO glitter allowed in the auditorium. Glitter must be applied to dancers at home.
20. Performers need to line up to stage left with our backstage managers two numbers before their next dance. We will be on a strict schedule, and we will not wait for your child; therefore, please be prompt. All backstage managers will be wearing red security t-shirts.
21. Parents will not be allowed backstage. No exceptions!
22. Parents with wristbands must pick up performers 9 and under from our backstage managers. This will ensure your child's safety.
23. Stay seated and quiet while dancers are on stage. Please wait to get up and move around in between numbers.
24. Please use back door/entrance only when entering or leaving the main auditorium.
25. Strollers will be allowed in the facility. However, you will have to keep it parked away from the chairs.
26. Lastly, please do not stop and ask **ANY** of the teachers' questions before or during the recitals. We will be busy trying to put on a show. We will be glad to take pictures and answer any questions **AFTER** each show!

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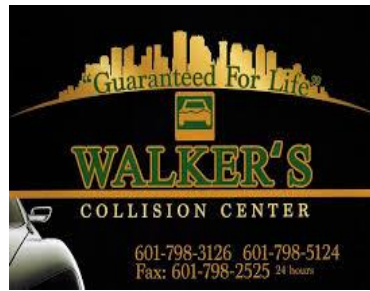
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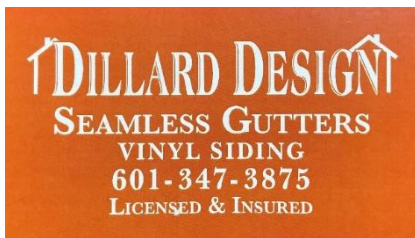
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
